



Christmas tree Collection Sites in Sarpy County for: 2009-2010

Please remove all ornaments, lights, tinsel and tree stands before dropping off your tree at the collection sites. A waste receptacle will be at each collection site for the disposal of the tree bag. Please remove the tree bag at the collection site and place in the waste receptacle. This will help with the Christmas tree recycling during the grinding process.

Collection sites for Christmas trees will be open to the public on the following dates:

- **December 26th, 2009 through January 10th, 2010**

Christmas tree collection sites for Sarpy County are as follows:

- **Wehrspann Lake**: Hwy 370, west of I-80. The south parking lot entry to Wildlife Mgmt. Area (will be recycled)
- **Bellevue**: Haworth Park at Hwy 370 & Payne Drive (collection site only)
- **Papillion**: Senior Center at 1001 Limerick Road & Papio Bay at 815 E. Halleck St. (both sites will be recycled)
- **LaVista**: Sports Complex at 66th St., 2 blocks South of Harrison & Kelley West Park 87th Street & Park View Blvd. (both sites will be recycled)
- **Gretna**: At the Sewer Lift Station, 11274 South 216th Street (A sign will be posted, pointing the direction)

The Sarpy County Division of Environmental Control will begin grinding the Christmas trees collected over the holidays at the collection sites in Sarpy County. The Sarpy County Landfill staff will deliver the Morbark 1200 Industrial Tub Grinder to the Wehrspann Lake collection site the week of January 10, 2010 at 8:00 A.M. The chips are to be used at the park for beneficial use with the park maintenance program.

The men with the Morbark 1200 are landfill personnel, please say hello or wave to Brian Heisner, Mike Pribyl, and Jerry Reed.

**This is a tentative schedule for the grinding of the collected trees at the Sarpy County sites and may change due to weather conditions.*

The next location that the Morbark 1200 Tub Grinder will be moved to will be the

LaVista grind site located at the LaVista Sports Complex on 66th Street two blocks south of Harrison Street on the east side of 66th Street in the gravel parking lot. The Morbark 1200 will commence grinding at 11:30 A. M. and continue until all trees have been chipped that were collected at the two collection sites for the City of LaVista.

The Sarpy County Divisions of Environmental Control will authorize grinding at the Papillion grind site located just off Lincoln Road at the Papillion Public Works Maintenance Materials Storage site.
